Voluntary Popcorn Recall

On February 4, the Weaver Popcorn Company (Trail's End parent company) issued a voluntary recall of the 9.5 oz Caramel Corn with Peanuts (the \$8 caramel corn tin with code date markings of "102861 109 JAN 19 08" through "102861 297 JUL 23 09") as a precaution against the Salmonella findings from the Peanut Corporation of America. This is the only product included in the recall.

Please note that no complaints or illnesses have been reported from this product.
