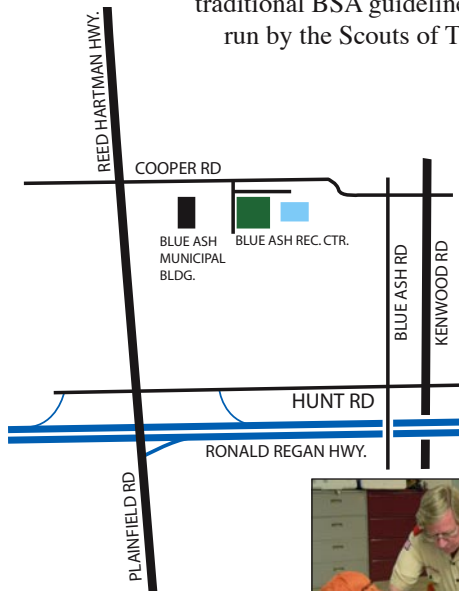


Troop Meetings

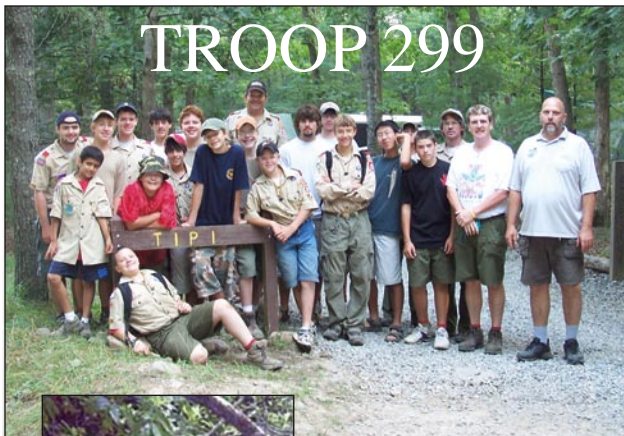

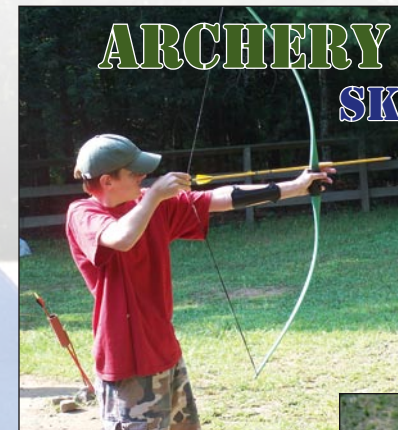
